Spelling the /ch/ Sound

There are two ways that we can spell the /ch/ sound found at the end of words: -tch and -ch. To decide which to use, it's important to look at the vowel sound before. If there is a short vowel sound, use -tch. If there is a long vowel sound, use -ch.

hatch
roach
stretch
each

Week Two

Spelling the /ou/ Sound

There are two different ways that we can spell the /ou/ sound: ow and ou.

Example Words

crowd
plow
proud
mouth

Week Three

Spelling the /aw/ Sound

There are many different ways to spell the /aw/ sound: au, aw, al, o

Example Words

sauce
gnaw
chalk
boss
